Guatemala - The associate weaves of *Samjel B'atz* are generally indigenous women weavers who have united in cooperatives as a response to Guatemala's grave economic situation. Many of them are widowed or displaced from their homes and continue their weaving as an act of economic as well as cultural survival. Centuries of Mayan traditions are reflected in the bright colours, symbols and designs of these weavings.

Thailand - Hundreds of tribal families are finding a partial answer to their need for cash income by selling their beautiful handicrafts. By so doing they are able to provide more adequate nutrition for their families, educate their children, obtain needed medical care, and in general raise their standard of living.
